	Incident overview			A pin-hole leak was found on the backside of the cascade system filter pot. Approximately 100 litres of produced water was spilled onto the building floor and into secondary containment system.
INVESTIGATION CONCLUSIONS	Site, system and components			The filter pot under normal conditions contains the produced water. In the event of a leak the fluid is contained by a lined secondary containment system designed to protect contamination of the soil outside the building.
	Failure scenario(s)			- Active corrosion on filter pot.
	Facts and evidence			- The vessel is in-service in a corrosive environment.
N	Causes and contributing factors			It is plausible that active corrosion on the filter pot contributed to this leak.
